Scottish PVG Scheme

Background

In 2011 the Scottish Government introduced the Protecting Vulnerable Groups (PVG) Scheme, for any one working in regulated activity with children, young people and adults at risk. The Scheme is managed by Disclosure Scotland. The PVG Scheme replaces enhanced and standard disclosures and members of the Scheme are regularly monitored. When new vetting information is available, consideration is given as to whether that person should be referred to the Barred List. Any individual who is on the Barred List cannot work in regulated activity or apply to the PVG Scheme.
