

LTA Tennis Leader Award

Venue: David Lloyd Hatfield, Spring 2014

The LTA Tennis Leader Award is aimed at young people aged 13 years plus, and is the first step on the tennis and sport career pathway for volunteering and paid employment. The course has been designed to offer a wide range of opportunities to young people providing them with enhanced skills and experience.

To call yourself a Tennis Leader you must complete the Introduction to Tennis module, plus one additional module. The LTA encourage people to do all additional modules, as you will gain different skills and a broader range of experience. To further support your learning, part of the course requirement is to get involved and volunteer at your local place to play by supporting a qualified coach, teacher or community project manager in your 'Tennis Leader' role.
