EDITORIAL

It is pleasing to report that the number of Lancashire juniors satisfying the LTA's criteria for regularly competing juniors rose to 1896 in 2012. That they have the opportunities to compete in the area is down to the work of the staff in the County Office who organise the winter circuits, the club volunteers who organise events at their venues, and all those volunteers who organise the junior leagues and teams throughout the county.

The number of Licensed or Registered coaches working in Lancashire also rose, to 146 in 2012, and it is they who take much credit for the ever-improving standards of play amongst our juniors. Nor must we forget the parents who spend time and money ferrying their offspring to and from training and competitions.



One of the big challenges now is to keep these youngsters in the game after they leave the junior ranks. The County Development Officers and several of our clubs have led the way in the past two years by staging more Over 18 competitions, but the challenge is now with all the registered clubs to take up the baton and develop programmes of events and activities, both playing and social, which will encourage junior players to join, retain their memberships, and to bring in their parents and friends.

The technology is there, different sized rackets, lower compression balls so that everyone can enjoy the game at their own level. I would suggest that same size fits all won't do any more. Why be slaves to the yellow ball with adult beginners now that the green ball is there to get people started more easily? Why not have a spare court at tournaments where non-playing parents can have a go?

Some clubs already have imaginative weekly programmes where starter tennis activities run side by side with the more experienced players practising together. However, perhaps others could benefit from moving away from traditional ideas such as that Saturday and Sunday afternoons are for yellow-ball social tennis only, and begin to offer a more varied timetable of activities.

IN REMEMBRANCE

We have to record the sad loss during the past year of the following good servants of Lancashire tennis over many years.

Roy Taylor

Roy was County President in 1978 and represented the Blackpool area on Council for many years right up until 2012. He was a keen publicist of tennis and always made sure that there were reports in the local newspapers of County Week and the County Championships.

Darrell Shaw

Darrell was a stalwart of the strong Lancashire Men's teams of the 1950s. He was three times county singles champion. In 1959, partnering Alan Mills (later the Wimbledon referee) he won all 15 rubbers during County Week at Eastbourne. He was known for making diving volleys on the grass some 25 years before Boris Becker. Darrell also played at Wimbledon, where he once partnered the exotic American Karol Fageros who drew press attention for wearing gold lame and black lace knickers under her tennis skirt, not typical attire for the times.

David Gunson

David was another county stalwart of the 1950s and 1960s. He was twice county singles champion, in 1957 and 1960, and runner-up in 1966. David also played at Wimbledon. Your editor, who came to the game late, gained valuable experience playing against David several times in the late 1960s and can testify first hand as to what a tough opponent David was whilst at the same time being an absolute gentleman.

MEN'S COUNTY TEAM MAKE PROGRESS

After some setbacks in 2011, captain Andy Davies rallied the troops in 2012. A strong squad hauled the team up from Group 3 into Group 2 in the Summer County Cup. Then in November the team topped their group in the Winter County Cup to secure a place in Group 1 for 2013.

Rachael Hyland's Ladies' team did not quite reach the heights of 2011, but creditably retained their Summer County Cup Group 1 status for 2013. Also they only narrowly missed out on promotion in November's Winter County Cup.

18U BOYS

Tony Lawson and his colleagues have worked hard with determination and persistence to achieve the requisite funding and permissions.

The club once again qualified for the AEGON Team Tennis National Finals weekend in both the Men's and Ladies' competitions. The Ladies' Team was only narrowly beaten in the competition final by the powerful Roehampton club.



BETH ASKEW - JUNIOR NATIONAL CHAMPION

Lancashire's Beth Askew won the 18U Girls Singles at the AEGON British Junior National Championships at Nottingham in August 2012. The 17 year-old Merseysider, seeded fifteenth, beat top-seeded Alicia Barnett 3 – 6, 6 – 2, 6 – 3.

Sabrina Federici also did well at the Championships, reaching the semi-final of the 16U Girls Singles.

THE HSBC ROAD TO WIMBLEDON 2012

The County Finals of the HSBC Road to Wimbledon competition were held at South Ribble Tennis Centre over the weekend of 7th – 8th July 2012.

All the winners from singles events held in tennis clubs and centres throughout the county competed to win the chance to compete in the National Finals.

The Boys Singles was won by Josh Webster who beat Robert Edwards in the final, whilst Holly Clark overcame Meggy Hague-Foale in the Girls Singles.

Meggy, Robert and Josh then went to the National finals in August and enjoyed a week of competition on the grass courts at the Bank of England Sports Ground, Roehampton. Wimbledon itself was unavailable this year because of the Olympics.

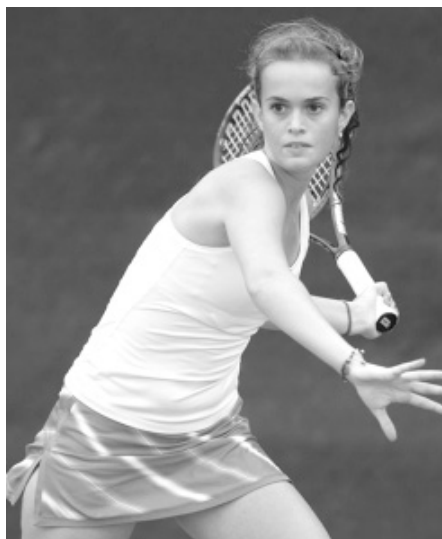

RULES OF LANCASHIRE LTA

1. NAME:

The Association shall be called Lancashire Lawn Tennis Association, trading as Tennis Lancashire.

2. LANCASHIRE - Boundary:

For the purpose of these rules "Lancashire" means the County of Lancashire, together with those parts of the former Metropolitan Counties of Greater Manchester and of Merseyside which were previously in the County of Lancashire;

3. OBJECTS:

The objects of the Association are:

- (a) to advance and safeguard the interests of tennis in Lancashire; to act jointly with the LTA as the governing body for tennis within Lancashire (see rule 2); to advance and safeguard the interests of tennis; to promote participation at all levels of tennis and generally to do all such acts, matters and things in connection with, or incidental, thereto;
- (b) to take and retain a membership interest with the LTA and to comply with and uphold throughout Lancashire the LTA Rules and the LTA Disciplinary Code and the rules and regulations of any person or body to which the LTA is registered or affiliated;
- (c) subject to the LTA Rules and the LTA Disciplinary Code, to make, amend and revoke rules and regulations for the control and governance of tennis in Lancashire; to decide doubtful and disputed matters in connection with tennis in Lancashire and to be responsible for the disciplining of players, officials, coaches and others involved within tennis in Lancashire;
- (d) to improve the standard of all matters relating to tennis in Lancashire;
- (e) subject to the LTA Rules, the LTA Disciplinary Code and the LTA's wider jurisdiction, to consider and resolve disputes, and to enforce any award or decision arising in connection with tennis in Lancashire or otherwise delegated to it by the LTA, and to provide by these rules, regulations, bye-laws or otherwise for a process to govern such disputes;
- (f) to appoint a representative or representatives for the County to the Council of the LTA;
- (g) to employ or to invest the funds of the Association in such a manner as shall be deemed in the best interests of tennis in Lancashire, including the purchase, lease, sale, maintenance and development of any real or personal property and any tennis equipment and effects with power to borrow money and to mortgage or charge its property and undertaking or any part thereof and to issue securities whether outright or as a security for any debt, liability or obligation to the Association or any third party and to lease or sub-let to organisations affiliated to the Association its property and undertaking or any part thereof or otherwise deal with and dispose of the same as may be thought fit;
- (h) to promote, arrange and regulate inter-county matches, county championships, tournaments, inter-club and county competitions and junior activities at all levels and age groups and to select teams for inter-county matches and competitions and generally to do all such acts, matters and things in connection with or incidental thereto;
- (i) to deal with such matters as may be referred to it by the Lawn Tennis Association, including where necessary applications by clubs and committees in Lancashire for the establishment of new tournaments, championships and competitions or the alteration of the dates of any such events;
- (j) to advance and safeguard the interests of the players of the game at all levels within Lancashire and to do whatever possible to further the tennis career of any person or persons of any age ordinarily resident in Lancashire;

- (k) to promote the teaching and development of tennis in the County and in particular the development of junior tennis in the County, and to promote, encourage and support coach education, the function of competition organisers, referees and umpires and the training of coaches, teachers, competition organisers, referees and umpires;
- (l) to arrange, purchase and distribute tickets allocated to the County for The Championships in accordance with the guidelines laid down by the LTA and the ticket terms and conditions issued by The All England Lawn Tennis and Croquet Club;
- (m) generally to perform all such acts in connection with or incidental to the effective carrying out of any of the objects mentioned in the previous sub-clauses of this rule and to employ the funds of the Association for any and for all of those objects;
- (n) to acquire, dispose of, establish, own, lease, operate, use and turn to account in any way tennis court facilities within the County together with buildings and easements, fixtures and fittings and accessories as shall be thought advisable and;
- (o) the Association is constituted by these Rules as a non-profit making organisation. In no circumstances during the continuance of the Association, nor after its dissolution, should any asset or surplus funds be distributed to any member or other person, nor to any organisation, which is not itself either constituted as non-profit making or a charity.

4 AFFILIATION: RELATIONSHIP with the LTA:

- (a) The Association shall be a member of the Lawn Tennis Association Ltd. As a result the Lancashire LTA will have one vote at the Annual General Meeting of the Lawn Tennis Association Ltd.
- (b) The Association's maximum liability to the LTA will be £1.00.

5 DEFINITIONS:

In these Rules:

- (a) "Member" means an individual or registered organisation.
- (b) "registered organisation" means an organisation which meets the criteria laid down in the Rules of the Lawn Tennis Association Ltd and which has paid the fee determined by the County Association's Council as payable by registered organisations and has been registered as an associate by the Association;
- (c) "address" includes a number or address used for sending or receiving documents or information by electronic means;
- (d) "Councillor" means a councillor of the County Association;
- (e) "LTA" shall mean the Lawn Tennis Association Limited (the governing body of tennis within Great Britain, Channel Islands and the Isle of Man) and its subsidiaries or such successor entity or entities as become(s) the governing body of tennis within Great Britain, Channel Islands and the Isle of Man from time to time;
- (f) "LTA Disciplinary Code" means the disciplinary code of the LTA in force from time to time;
- (g) "LTA Rules" means the rules of the LTA as in force from time to time;

6 MEMBERSHIP:

The Association shall consist of the members of Council and any league or organisation willing to conform to the Association's rules and regulations.

An organisation shall qualify for registration, and thereby for registration as an associate of the LTA, if the Council of the Association deems (within the LTA guidelines) that it provides organised tennis opportunities within the County, including but not limited to:

- (a) a members or commercial tennis club;
- (b) a park based tennis programme;

- (c) a school based tennis programme for the community which operates out of curriculum hours;
- (d) a pay and play tennis centre;
- (e) a tennis academy; and /or
- (f) a further education or higher education tennis club provided, in each case, that it has a written constitution or set of rules governing its operation approved by the Council

The registration period runs from 1st October to 30th September in any year. Before the final day of November in each year, every registered organisation shall update its registration with the LTA on line, and shall pay the charge generated by the updated registration directly to Tennis Lancashire.

Any person or registered organisation desiring to withdraw from the Association shall give written notice of the fact to the Secretary and that notice shall take effect on the next following 31st December. If such notice is not given, that person or registered organisation shall be liable to pay the subscription for the subsequent year, commencing on 1st January.

7 FEES:

- (a) The annual subscription for each type of member shall be determined from time to time by the Council and shall be effective for that year. Such annual subscription may exceed the minimum annual subscription described below.
- (b) The minimum annual subscription for each registered organisation referred to in rule 6, which shall be deemed to include any taxation which may be payable thereon, shall be calculated by multiplying the number of courts of each surface to which that organisation has "regular access" (whether through a lease, user agreement and/or such other arrangement or understanding) by the applicable "court fee". Court fees shall be determined by the LTA; regular access means access on an exclusive basis for at least 15 hours per week (for at least 40 weeks per year).
- (c) In respect of organisations referred to in rule 6 that do not have "regular access" to tennis courts, a fixed minimum annual subscription, determined annually by the Association, shall apply.
- (d) Unless the LTA determines otherwise on a case by case basis, the annual subscription fee for organisations referred to in rule 6 in respect of each year to 30 September shall be payable between 1 October and the following 28 February.
- (e) The annual subscription fee for organisations referred to in rule 6 shall be paid to Tennis Lancashire.
- (f) The annual subscription fee for organisations referred to in rule 6 shall include the amount, if any, payable in respect of benefits or services provided by the LTA.
- (g) Any organisation referred to in rule 6 whose subscription remains unpaid for one calendar month after the receipt of notice of membership, or whose annual subscription in any subsequent year remains unpaid by 1 March, shall, if the LTA so resolves, cease to be eligible for grants and other advantages offered to members by the LTA.
- (h) Any member organisation whose subscription fee is not paid by such date as the Council shall decide each year shall be deemed to have resigned its membership of the Association.

8. EXPULSION:

- (a) The Council shall have power to expel a member organisation when, in its opinion, it would not be in the interests of the Association for it to remain a member.
- (b) A member organisation shall not be expelled unless it is given both 14 days' written notice to attend a meeting of the Council and written details of the complaint made against it.
- (c) The member organisation shall be given an opportunity to appear before the Council to answer complaints made against it and must not be expelled unless at least two-thirds of the Council then present vote in favour of its expulsion.

9. OFFICERS:

- (a) The Officers of the Association shall be the President, a maximum of four Vice-Presidents, the Chairman of the Council, the Secretary and the Treasurer.
- (b) A person may hold more than one office concurrently.
- (c) Every person who has held the office of President shall automatically become a Life Vice-President.

10 COUNCIL:

- (a) The Association shall have a Council consisting of the following:
 - (i) the President; the Chairman, the Honorary Secretary and Honorary Treasurer; the immediate Past President, the Vice Presidents (minimum of two and a maximum of four);
 - (ii) the Ladies' Captain, the Men's Captain, the Ladies' Veterans' Organiser, the Men's Veterans' Organiser;
 - (iii) a maximum of three further Past Presidents (Life Vice-Presidents). In November of each year, the Secretary shall invite the Past Presidents of the Association to elect this maximum of three representatives. In the event of more than three nominations being received a ballot shall be held prior to the Annual General Meeting;
 - (iv) each registered league may appoint one Councillor. Those leagues with more than 20 clubs may appoint an additional Councillor. A Councillor may be appointed to represent those clubs not playing in a registered league within the County;
 - (v) up to six additional Councillors elected annually;
 - (vi) the chairman for the time being of any committee appointed by the Council or of any panel or project appointed group appointed by the Executive Committee;
 - (vii) the Ladies' Competition Organiser and the Men's Competition Organiser;
 - (viii) the representative or representatives of Lancashire on the Council of the LTA elected annually by the Council;
 - (ix) up to two duly accredited representatives of the Local Authorities affiliated to the Association;
 - (x) a duly accredited representative of the Lancashire Tennis Patrons' Club.
- (b) The Council shall appoint trustees, on such terms as the Council may think fit, to hold office until death or resignation unless removed from office by a resolution of the Council. The Chairman from time to time is nominated as the person to appoint new trustees within the meaning of Section 36 of the Trustee Act 1925. A new trustee or new trustees shall be nominated by resolution of the Council and the Chairman shall by deed duly appoint the person or persons so nominated as the new trustee or trustees of the Association and the provisions of the Trustee Act 1925 shall apply to any such appointment. Any statement of fact in any such deed of appointment shall in favour of a person dealing with the Association or the Committee in good faith be conclusive evidence of the fact so stated. The number of trustees shall not be more than four or less than two. The property of the Association, other than cash at the bank, shall be vested in the trustees. They shall deal with the property as directed by resolution of the Council and entry in the minute book shall be conclusive evidence of such a resolution. The Trustees shall be indemnified against risk, claims and expenses, properly incurred by them in the discharge of their duties, out of the funds and property of the Association.
- (c) The Tennis Operations Manager, The Tennis Development Manager, the LTA Talent and Performance Manager, the Tennis Development Officers, the Talent and Performance Co-ordinator, the Chairman of the Lancashire Tennis Junior Development Trust Limited and the Independent Examiner shall be invited to Council meetings and shall have the right to attend and to speak, but not to vote, at all Council meetings.

- (d) Members of Council shall be deemed to have vacated office if:
 - (i) they resign their office by notice in writing to the Association;
 - (ii) they without sufficient reason for more than three consecutive meetings of the Council have been absent without permission of the Council and the Council resolves that their office be vacated;
 - (iii) they are suspended from holding office or from taking part in any activity relating to the administration or management of the Association by a decision of the LTA; or
 - (iv) they are requested to resign by all the other Council members acting together.

11. POWERS OF COUNCIL:

- (a) The Council shall be responsible for the management of the Association and shall have power:
 - (i) to carry out (whether through committees, panels or project groups appointed under the provisions of paragraph (vi) of this Rule or otherwise) the objects of the Association specified in Rule 3, except those which can only be dealt with by the Association in general meeting;
 - (ii) to consider and deal with all applications for registration by prospective organisations and to decide all questions as to the right of attendance and representation at general meetings;
 - (iii) to regulate the procedure for all its meetings;
 - (iv) to appoint the Association's representative or representatives on the Council of the LTA;
 - (v) to appoint, and to delegate to, the Men's Captain, the Ladies' Captain, the Ladies' Veterans' Organiser and the Men's Veterans' Organiser such powers as it may think proper;
 - (vi) to appoint an Executive Committee to whom the Council may delegate all or any of its powers, including the power to appoint in its turn panels or project groups;
 - (vii) to enlist by co-option for any purpose the services of any person or persons who is or are not members of the Council;
 - (viii) to decide all questions and disputes between registered organisations and all disciplinary matters regarding individuals which may be sent to it for decision (reserving to itself the right to refer any matter to the Council of The Lawn Tennis Association) and to prohibit any act or practice within Lancashire which, in the opinion of the Council is detrimental to tennis or the best interests of the Association and to deal with any offending registered organisation or person in any way (including the imposition of any suspension or ban) which the Council may think appropriate;
 - (ix) to decide all matters relating to the management of the Association;
 - (x) to approve the design of, and to award, Lancashire Colours, Honorary Lancashire Colours and Junior Lancashire Colours in accordance with Rule 17;
 - (xi) to delegate to any of the Officers all or any of its powers;
 - (xii) to appoint and determine the terms and conditions of service of employees of the Association;
 - (xiii) to enter into contracts for the purposes of the Association on behalf of all the members.
- (b) Council meetings shall be held as often as the Council thinks fit provided that there shall not be less than four meetings each year. The quorum of such meetings shall be twelve Councillors present in person. The Chairman and the Secretary shall have discretion

to call emergency meetings of the Council if they consider it to be in the interests of the Association. The Secretary shall give all the members of the Council not less than seven days' notice of a meeting.

12. EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE:

- (a) The Executive Committee appointed by the Council shall comprise the President, the Senior Vice-President, the Chairman of Council, the immediate Past President, the Secretary, the Treasurer, all Past Presidents of The Lawn Tennis Association who are Members of Council, the Representatives of Lancashire on the Council of The Lawn Tennis Association, three members of Council elected to serve on the Executive Committee by Council ("the elected Members") and the Tennis Development Manager.
- (b) Each of the elected Members shall serve on the Executive Committee for a period of three years. At the end of that period the elected Member shall retire by rotation, but shall be eligible for re-election immediately or on a subsequent occasion. If an elected Member resigns or otherwise becomes ineligible to continue as a Member of the Executive Committee, the Executive Committee shall have power to co-opt to fill that vacancy but such co-opted Member shall retire at the next Annual General Meeting and may offer himself for re-election.
- (c) The Executive Committee is allowed to co-opt up to a further two additional members, who in its opinion would bring further benefit to the Association.
- (d) The Executive Committee shall meet on at least six occasions each year. Unless Council otherwise decides, the Chairman of Council shall chair meetings of the Executive Committee. In his absence, the Members of the Executive Committee shall elect a Chairman for that meeting from among those present.
- (e) The Association agrees that the Association's Councillors and each member of the Executive Committee, will be required, as a condition of election or appointment, to agree to be bound by and subject to these rules, the LTA Rules and the LTA Disciplinary Code, such agreement to contain an express acknowledgement that the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Act 1999 applies and that the LTA and the Association can enforce any breach at its option and in its sole discretion.

13. FINANCE:

- (a) All money payable to the Association shall be received by the persons authorised by the Council to receive such money and shall be deposited in a bank account in the name of the Association. No sum shall be drawn from any account of the Association except in accordance with the conditions and limits agreed by the Council from time to time.
- (b) The Council shall have power to authorise the payment of remuneration and expenses to any Officer, Member of the Council, Member or Employee of the Association and to any other person or persons for services rendered to the Association.
- (c) The financial transactions of the Association shall be recorded in such manner as the Council thinks fit by the Treasurer.
- (d) The financial year of the Association shall close on 30th September in each year. An annual statement of the accounts for each financial year shall be prepared by the Treasurer and examined by the Independent Examiner as soon as possible thereafter. The accounts must be made available to every member when notice concerning the annual general meeting is given.

14. GENERAL MEETINGS:

- (a) The annual general meeting of the Association shall be held during the four months' period commencing on the day immediately following the day on which the financial year of the Association closes at a place and on a date to be fixed by the Council. The ordinary business of the annual general meeting shall be to receive the report of the Council and the Hon. Treasurer's statement of accounts for the past year, duly independently examined, and to elect the elective Officers, the elective members of the Council and the Independent Examiner for the ensuing year.

- (b) An extraordinary general meeting of the Association may be convened by the Council whenever it thinks fit and shall be convened by the Hon Secretary before the expiry of a period of 28 days commencing on the date of the receipt by him of a request in writing from four or more Councillors or registered organisations asking him to do so and stating the purpose for which the meeting is to be called. No other business shall be transacted at such a meeting. If the requisitioned meeting is not called before the expiry of a period of 21 days commencing on the date of that request, the requisitionists may call the meeting at any time before the expiry of a period of two months commencing on the date of that request.
- (c) No other business, other than the formal adjournment of the meeting, shall be transacted at any general meeting unless a quorum is present and that quorum shall consist of not less than twelve persons entitled to vote present in person.
- (d) All ordinary business of a general meeting shall be decided by a simple majority of the votes properly recorded at that meeting, but all business at an extraordinary meeting shall be decided by a two-thirds majority of the votes properly recorded at that meeting.
- (e) At a general meeting, every question shall be decided by a show of hands unless prior to any vote being taken a ballot is (i) directed by the chairman, or (ii) demanded by not less than three persons present who are entitled to vote. The procedure for any ballot shall be decided by the chairman of the meeting.
- (f) In the case of any equality of votes, the chairman shall have a second, casting vote.
- (g) Notice of all general meetings shall be sent to the members of the Council, Life Vice-Presidents, the Tennis Operations Manager, the Tennis Development Manager, the LTA Talent and Performance Manager, the Tennis Development Officer(s), the Talent and Performance Co-ordinator, the Chairman of the Lancashire Tennis Junior Development Trust Limited and the Independent Examiner and to all registered organisations, at least fourteen days prior to the date fixed for each meeting. Such notice shall specify the date, time and place of the meeting, the business to be transacted and, in the case of an annual general meeting, the names of the persons nominated as elective Officers and elective members of the council for the ensuing year. The accidental failure to give any such notice to any person entitled thereto, or the accidental omission of any such details in any notice, shall not invalidate the proceedings at any general meeting.
- (h) Any general meeting of the Association shall be chaired by the President, unless the meeting votes otherwise by a simple majority.

15. ADMISSION TO AND VOTING AT GENERAL MEETINGS:

- (a) Admission: General meetings shall be open to members of the Council, Life Vice-Presidents and all members of registered organisations. The Tennis Operations Manager, the Tennis Development Manager, the Talent and Performance Manager, the Tennis Development Officer(s), the Talent and Performance Co-ordinator, the Chairman of the Lancashire Tennis Junior Development Trust Limited and the Independent Examiner may also attend and may speak, but not vote.
- (b) Voting: Each registered organisation (providing that the organisation is not in arrears with its subscriptions) shall be entitled to send one representative with power of voting in respect of every fifty paid up members of that registered organisation, subject to an overall maximum of four representatives with power of voting for each registered organisation. Every member of the Council shall be entitled to vote, even though the registered organisation of which they are a member is fully represented at the meeting. Representatives of registered organisations must be members of, or properly nominated by, the organisation which they represent.
- (c) There shall be no right for a member to vote by proxy. No person may represent more than one member.

16. NOMINATIONS AND MOTIONS:

- (a) Any registered organisation may nominate, for the ensuing year, one candidate for each of the offices held by the Officers. The Council and/or any Executive Committee appointed by the Council may nominate for the ensuing year, one candidate for each of

- the offices held by the Officers. All nominations by the Council, the Executive Committee and registered organisations shall be sent to the Secretary at the Association's office at least twenty-one days before the date of the annual general meeting.
- (b) The retiring Officers and Councillors shall continue to hold office until the conclusion of the annual general meeting or any adjournment of that meeting. All persons retiring shall be eligible to stand for re-election.
 - (c) Any vacancy amongst the Officers or Councillors not filled at an annual general meeting and any casual vacancy occurring from time to time may be filled by the Council at its discretion.
 - (d) The Council, and/or any Executive Committee appointed by the Council or any registered organisation may bring forward any proposition, resolution or motion at the annual general meeting, provided that, in the case of registered organisations, due notice thereof is given in writing to the Secretary on or before 1st November immediately preceding the annual general meeting.

17. COLOURS:

- (a) County Colours shall be a badge showing the Lancashire Red Rose and the words "County Colours" in green worn on men's and ladies' tennis tops, sweaters, jumpers and track suit tops.
- (b) The Colours tie shall be two broad red stripes bordering a narrow gold stripe, diagonally on a background of dark green.
- (c) Colours shall be awarded by the Council on the recommendation of the Men's and of the Ladies' Captains or as the Council deems fit to players who have represented Lancashire in eight or more matches in the Summer County Cup Championships or the Winter County Cup Indoor Championships.
- (d) The Council may by two-thirds' majority of those present, award Honorary Colours for special services rendered to tennis or to the Association. Holders of Honorary Colours may wear the Colours tie.
- (e) Junior Colours shall be awarded by the Council to members of the teams taking part in the Junior County Cup on the recommendation of the County Coach or as the Council deems fit. Junior Colours shall be a Lancashire Rosebud over the word "Junior", embroidered on a white background. The Junior Colours badge may be worn with a variety of clothing.
- (f) Members of the Patrons' Club may wear the County tie. The County tie shall be a red rose of Lancashire over gold letters LCLTA enclosed within two diagonals of narrow red-gold-red stripes, all on a dark green background.

18. DISCIPLINE:

- (a) A Disciplinary Committee shall be formed as and when required and shall consist of three members of the Executive Committee appointed by the Chairman of the Council or failing him the President, who will also nominate the Chairman of the Disciplinary Committee.
- (b) In the event of its decision being subject to an appeal, the Chairman of the Council shall chair an appeals committee consisting of one member of the Council appointed by the President of the Association, and who is not a member of the Executive Committee, and one independent person chosen by the player or organisation who has appealed.
- (c) The procedure for any disciplinary hearing shall be as set out in the LTA Disciplinary Code.

19. INDEMNITY CLAUSE:

The Association shall indemnify out of the assets of the Association every member of its Council, committees, panels and project groups, against any demands, claims, awards, costs, expenses, losses and liabilities incurred directly or indirectly in the execution of the activities in good faith on behalf of the Association.

20 NOTICES:

- (a) The Association can send, make available or supply any notice, ballot paper, accounts, document, or other information:-
 - (i) by personal delivery;
 - (ii) by posting it to the intended recipient's usual address;
 - (iii) by sending or supplying it in electronic form to an address notified by the intended recipient to the Association; or
 - (iv) by making it available on a website and notifying the intended recipient of its availability in accordance with this Rule.
- (b) If any notice, ballot paper, accounts, document or other information is left by the Association at the intended recipient's usual address, it is treated as being received on the day it was left.
- (c) If any notice, ballot paper, accounts, document or other information is sent or supplied by the Association by post, it is treated as being received the day after it was posted if first class post was used or 72 hours after it was posted if first class post was not used. In proving that any notice, ballot paper, accounts, document, or other information was sent, it is sufficient to show that the envelope was properly addressed and put into the postal system with postage paid.
- (d) If any notice, ballot paper, accounts, document or other information is sent, made available or supplied by using electronic means, it is treated as being received on the day it was sent. In the case of any notice, ballot paper, accounts, document or other information made available on a website, the notice, ballot paper, accounts, document, or other information is treated as being received on the day on which it was first made available on the website;

21. DISSOLUTION:

- (a) A resolution to dissolve the Association shall only be proposed at an extraordinary general meeting and shall only be passed if carried by a majority of at least three quarters of the members present and entitled to vote.
- (b) The dissolution shall take effect from the date of the resolution and the Members of the Council shall be responsible for the winding-up of the assets and liabilities of the Association.
- (c) Any property remaining after the discharge of the debts and liabilities of the Association shall be paid to or distributed as agreed, in Rule 2, by the Members by resolution at the time of dissolution to the LTA, any other non-profit making body with similar objects or any tennis related charity.

22. ALTERATION IN RULES:

No alteration or amendment shall be made to these rules and no new rule shall be made save at a general meeting, after due notice has been given in accordance with these Rules. Any alteration, amendment or new rule so made shall take effect forthwith unless the meeting shall otherwise decide.

23. CONDITIONS OF REGISTRATION OF ASSOCIATES:

- (a) Each registered organisation agrees as a condition of association:
 - (i) to be bound by and subject to these rules (as in force from time to time);
 - (ii) to be bound by and subject to the LTA Rules and the LTA Disciplinary Code; and
 - (iii) to ensure that its underlying members, any unlicensed and unregistered coaches and, so far as reasonably practicable, players using its facilities (the "registered organisation's connected parties") are bound by and subject to the LTA Rules and the LTA Disciplinary Code by obtaining the formal agreement of the registered

organisation's connected parties, as a condition of membership, association, registration, election or as otherwise appropriate, to be bound by and subject to the LTA Rules and the LTA Disciplinary Code, such agreement to contain an express acknowledgement that the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Act 1999 applies and that the LTA can enforce any breach at its option and in its sole discretion.

- (b) Rule 23.1 confers a benefit on the LTA and is intended to be enforceable by the LTA by virtue of the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Act 1999. For the avoidance of doubt, the registered organisations do not intend that any term of these rules, apart from rule 23.2 should be enforceable, by virtue of the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Act 1999, by any person who is not an associate.
- (c) The Executive Committee may terminate the association of any person, or impose any other sanction they determine to be appropriate, in connection with the breach of any condition set out in this rule.

24 USE OF FACILITIES:

The Association agrees that all unlicensed and unregistered coaches and, so far as reasonably practicable, players and other persons using the facilities of the Association or a registered organisation will be required, as a condition of such use, to agree to be bound by and subject to these rules, the LTA Rules and the LTA Disciplinary Code, such agreement to contain an express acknowledgement that the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Act 1999 applies and that the LTA and the Association can enforce any breach at its option and in its sole discretion.

25 REGULATIONS, BYE-LAWS AND STANDING ORDERS:

The Council shall have power to make, repeal and amend such regulations, bye-laws and standing orders as it may from time to time consider necessary, desirable or appropriate. Such regulations, bye-laws and standing orders shall have effect until repealed by the Council.

26 BORROWING:

The Council may borrow a maximum total amount of £50,000 on behalf of the Association for the purposes of the Association from time to time at its own discretion and with the sanction of an annual or extraordinary general meeting any further money above that sum.

When so borrowing the Council shall have power to raise in any way any sum or sums of money and to raise and secure the repayment of any sum or sums of money in such manner and on such terms and conditions as it thinks fit, and in particular by mortgage of or charge upon or by the issues of debentures charged upon all or any part of the property of the Association.

The Council shall have no power to pledge the personal liability of any associated organisation for repayment of any sums so borrowed.

The trustees shall, at the discretion of the Council, make such dispositions of the Association's property or any part thereof, and enter into and execute such agreements and instruments in relation thereto, as the Council may deem proper for giving security for such moneys and the interest payable thereon.
