Tournament Guidelines

Due to the change in Competition Age-Groups, effective from 1st September 2010, please note the birthdays eligible for each event:

ORANGE 1st April 2001 to 31st March 2002

or 1st April 2002 to 31st March 2003 (if R1 Rating)

GREEN 1st April 2000 to 31st March 2001

or 1st April 2001 to 31st August 2001 (if O1 Rating)

Play will commence at 9.00am each day for the boys event and 9.30am for the girls event.

Each player must arrive a minimum of 20 minutes before their official start time in order to register with the referee.

Changing Facilities, hot / cold food and refreshments and will be available from the tennis centre throughout the day.

This is an outdoor event. Indoor back up is provided should the weather make the courts unfit to play on.

Players' Information

PLEASE NOTE THE AGE-CHANGES EFFECTIVE FROM 1st SEPTEMBER 2010

The tournament will run under the regulations of the National Competition Framework

The Orange tournament will operate as each match being a single short set decided by a tie break should the score become 4 games all.

Approx 3/4 matches to conclude the tournament on the day

The Green tournament will operate as each match being best of 3 short sets with a deciding Match tie break (to 10 points) at one set all.

Approx 3 matches to conclude the tournament on the day.

The tournament will operate under the LTA code of conduct.

Entries close on **Wednesday 8th September 2010**. No late entries will be accepted via fax, email or otherwise.

No entry fees will be refunded after the draw has been completed.
(Entry fee £15.00)

Every competitor must be a British Tennis Member.

No complaint will be entertained unless submitted in writing and given to the tournament committee within 48 hours of complaint.

The referees' decision is final on all matters in connection with the tournament.

Tennis balls used will be the HEAD Tip 2 (Orange) and HEAD Tip 3 (Green).

Organising with your coach to be available for the duration of play is your sole responsibility; the tournament is not responsible for organising coach availability.

Communication with your coach is the basis of the tournament but should be made only at change of ends, or during the warm up. Play during the games should be uninterrupted.
